Membership report states we have 1544 members, 52 business associates,, with a total of 1596.

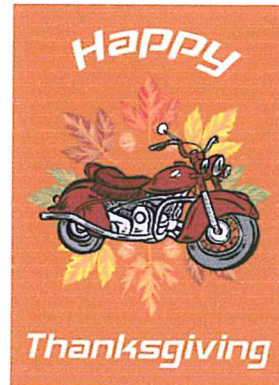
No nominations were made for vice coordinator. Thus, Jiggs has a few people in mind he wants to talk to ask to step in.

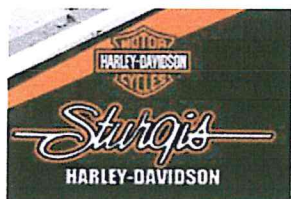
