Time will be from 1200-1530. Barb is still doing food. Good job Barbie.

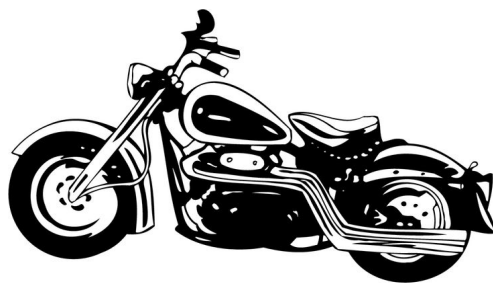
We need to get orders in for Legislative Days t-shirts by Sept. BOD meeting.
