OK so today you woke up and decided you want to get more involved in your government. Or maybe you listened to a news report on a certain bill proposed in the Legislature and it made you shake your head and wonder "what else are those people doing down there"? Or maybe you just wanted to get more informed or involved in the world around you. Well here is your chance to do that very thing.

MyLRC is a great way to stay informed on what's happening in the South Dakota Legislature. You can customize the information you receive based on your personal needs.

Want to know what bills a specific legislator sponsored? Add them to your My Session Members list. Interested in what a legislative committee is discussing? Have their agendas emailed to you. You can even follow specific bills as they make their way to the Governor's desk. Items available include:

- Bills
- Updates to Rules
- Updates to the Register
- Legislator Address Updates
- Press Releases

- Session Agendas, Calendars, Minutes, and Journals
- Bills that Could Affect a Statute You Select
- Revenue Report & Trust Fund Updates
- Interim Committee Agendas, Minutes and Documents

All this info is at your fingertips if you just ask. So how do I ask you say? Well that is just a few key-strokes away.

You can get there two ways. Either type in www.sdlegislature.gov and hit enter. Then on the top right of the page is a little square. Click it and a drop down box will appear on the left of your screen. Go into that box and scroll down to the bottom where it lists MyLRC. Just click it and it will take you to the opening page of My LRC. There you can create and account and be on your way.

If you just want to quick check things out in the Legislature the www.sdlegislature.gov page will allow you to see tons of stuff concerning the Legislature. You can check this session, past sessions. Codified law, and a myriad of other info.




