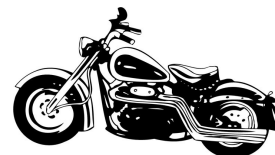

The regular July meeting was held with 2 Reps absent & one substitute which was approved. All officers were present except Treasurer, Membership Secretary & Products Manager.

The Secretary's report was given & the minutes were approved. The Treasurer was absent but sent in a report & it was approved.

The Membership Secretary was absent but sent in a report & it was approved. She also asked if more Road Hazard cards could be printed & that was approved.

Jiggs reported that the cost of membership is now listed on

the website.

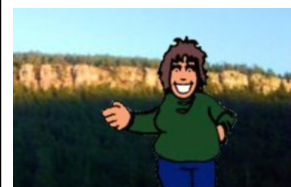

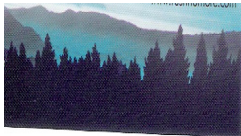

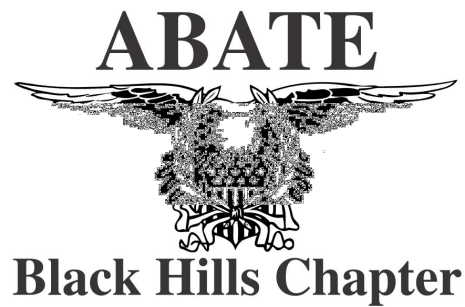
