# **Happenings on the State Level:**

# Jack Hendrickson /John Dale

Jiggs called the meeting to order. Minutes & treasurers report were approved. Everyone is encouraged to help with recruiting & retention. It is important for chapter secretaries to be timely getting membership information sent in.

Discussion was had about computers that could be replaced. An equipment schedule was set up to purchase 4 computers over the next 2 years. Costs are increasing for printing newsletters, shirts & other items for ABATE.

MRF is sorting through the self driving car issue to determine how well they can identify motorcycles. word on whether self driving motorcycles will someday be a thing.

Legislative days was well attended. ABATE members had good productive talks with legislators & others in Pierre. They are looking into moving the luncheon closer to the capitol to reduce commute time. It was suggested to use table tents or some other signage to help connect the members with the representatives quickly. There are currently no motorcycle bills on the table. Auto dealerships & truckers are important ABATE allies. The state is trying to attract motorcycle riding trainers, so they are discussing increasing compensation. The fund collected from the motorcycle registration is very high so Dianna is keeping a close eye on it.

The checks that are sent to candidates in various elections are some times not cashed or are sent back. We wait a year before they are cancelled.

Product sales were up at Legislative Days. Carl will order another 50-75 shirts/sweatshirts to replenish inventory. Old decals will be illegal. If you would like a new replacement decal to get legal, reach out to your chapter. ABATE will be ordering more yard signs. The tri-folds are finished an delivered. The 2023 SD Rides Calendar is out. Reach out to your chapter to get one for the critical information.

The gun & cash raffles seem to be the most popular approach. This was tabled until next month.

The Board has decided to send 6 people to Heartland STEAM in ND. Registration will be paid & 1/2 hotel paid. Bikers Inside the Beltway is all set.

Ride S.M.A.R.T. (Safely, Maturely, Aware, Respectful, Train) will have presence at the 100th Laconia event. It's a solid mind set.

Despite the membership fees being a consistent \$25/yr, ABATE spends \$31.45 per member on various services offered. Should we increase the affiliation fee for chapters from \$50 to \$100 dollars?




