Happenings on the State Level: Lisa Hatheway-Berry

The State BOD was called to order by State Coordinator Brad, lead with a moment of silence for a lost member, pledge was said. The meeting was called to order, with 11 chapters representing & 3 sub representing with 3 chapters absent. State officers all present but vice. Appointed all present, secretary's, treasure, and membership secretary's, report given and approved. Newsletter editors report given with a report of members not getting the emails of the newsletter. It could be in your spam, &/or junk mail please check that & if your email is not eligible to read, you will get it via mail.

Committee reports were given with the promotions stating that two members would like to try it at Algona & see how that goes, with promoting membership for our state. Was approved, with the discussion that if you do attend, please don't wait till the last minute to renew your membership, maybe a month or more before so you have your card. MRF the California Air Resources Board (CARB) announced a postponement of the planned hearing on motorcycle emissions policy. Ohio are pushing back against California's plans on the clean air act, with just before the end of 2023, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine signed H.B. 201 into law. IMPAC legislative days 2025 was discussed briefly with moving to a different date, recommendation was to stay with our normal dates just to move our time of our social. 2024 had a great turn out even with the bad weather. Dianna our lobbyist gave a short discussion on bills that are coming up and that she will post them to our website. Discussion on bill 1095 please see below. State product brought a new product in which sold out, shared a new design for stickers, was motioned to approve. Finance no report not present. Bylaws was discussion of policy & procedure that they are working on first, with it being stated that you read the LRC notes in the state newsletter, as there it is discussed what changes are being made.

Old business discussion was short. Motorcycle awareness training coming back this is still just the first class which will be in Sioux Falls, Rapid City & Pierre if you have not signed up, please do so. The web site is still a work in progress. Meeting of the Minds, absent no report was available will be in the state newsletter. COC donation was ta-

bled till next BOD meeting.

New business discussion on the state fundraiser of Wayne's quilt was a huge success! Heartland STEAM 2024 April 12-13th in Sioux Falls. Please get signed up & your rooms reserved. Only 1 design was submitted, was approved. It is strongly encouraged that every chapter be a BRONZE sponsor. Chapter table center pieces to be brought to the March BOD mtg, if its perishable please speak with Jiggs &/or if you will be there the opening day. They still need some volunteers to help, please let Jiggs know. Name tags are needed for new BOD & appointed tag was given. Bikers in the beltway, sending 3 people with 2 state officers & 1 advisor. Tickets & room have been bought for attendance. Road hazard program discussed with it being tabled as we would like to see some more data on calls & another phone program. Yard signs was discussed that we have enough probably in inventory.

1095 Autonomous Bill was a big discussion over, was motioned & moved (12-1) that we remain neutral in this at this time. There are some big supporters behind it & some of them we work very closely with. Now this doesn't mean that our voice will not be heard, what it means is that the groundwork on this bill needs to start somewhere. We are invited to attend the meetings &/or hearings, if we have concerns our voice will be heard. I know that as motorcyclists we throw up our arms when we hear autonomous, but the vehicles are already here folks, the ground rules need to be set for them. There will be a hearing on Wednesday January 24th 10AM on PBS.

In closing I would like to thank the Black Hills Chapter for nominating me as member of the year. I am humbled & honored by this nomination. And receiving it from Susan made it even more meaningful for me. Legislative days is an experience, I highly recommend if you have never been, make next year your year to go!


