Happenings on the State Level:

Lisa Hatheway-Berry

The January BOD meeting was brought to order at 10 o'clock. Fifteen chapters were present & one was absent. All state officers were present. One appointed position was present & two were vacant, with an interim.

The Secretary report was given with corrections by Oahe & Southeast, accepted, & moved.

The treasurer's report was presented & approved.

The membership report was given, with some discussion on the current memberships compared to those over the years.

Newsletter editor report was given, stating that she has been working on getting more state sponsorship from her chapter affiliates. It has been helping her when the chapters send her their chapter events for the year. There was a short discussion on leaving our newsletters at the motorcycle museum only during the months they have traffic, as she already does this.

Committee reports were given from the promotions that they will try to go to lowa for Algona.

The MRF report stated that he is still looking for someone to fill this position & an assistant(s) for this. There is a new congress & the old bills are gone & new ones will be rolled out. So, it is essential that you email or mail letters to your members of Congress.

California dropped the combustible engine clean truck, with Florida pushing it through. There was a study by the IHS on high-visibility clothing not being seen by automated vehicles.

The IMAPC legislative officer report was given with his thoughts on what could be done differently next year & how the IMPAC committee could get together 1 hour before the state BOD meetings.

There is some discussion in the capital about an increase in driver's license fees & a fee for autonomous vehicles. Diana, our lobbyist, was there & briefly discussed some of the 500-600 bills that could be coming through this session. She encouraged us to look on the state website for her updates. Bill #45, which has our \$7 fee that we pay when we register our bikes & ATVs. If something concerns her, she will contact Brad or Doug as soon as possible.

The state product report, with it being vacant, was a good event for products during Legislative Days. The Finance committee proposed that we hire a CPA to go over

our finances, audit & set a budget.

This was also the 2nd vote to increase the dues of membership. There was a vote to hear a discussion on this & it was voted not to listen to the debate & move to a vote. A 2/3 vote is needed to pass the vote; the vote was defeated, there will be no increase in dues.

The by-laws committee was motioned & approved with a vote to move forward with the policy & procedures and keep the bylaws the same.

Old business was a short discussion on motorcycle awareness, training & education grants that are helping with the accident scene management classes. If you have not taken these classes, I highly suggest that you do one. They will be offered in RC, SF & Pierre, with both the bystander class & advanced class being offered. A class for professional rescuers is being offered in RC & SF. The website is up & running and is working very well.

New business was another short discussion. It was brought up that several officers & appointed positions need a new laptop &/or a new external hard drive to support what they work with. A motion was made & approved to cap what to spend for these. There is no state fundraiser currently. The collaboration with the museum has been on hold since it's been busy with the holidays; maybe they can make that contact once again now that things have slowed down. Name tags were suggested as a replacement for a magnet for some who would like them.

For bikers in the Beltway, it was decided to set a cap for spending with a motion & approved. This will be from the BOD for any ABATE member of SD.

A few will attend STEAM & the BOD will pay for the hotel & registration fees for the BOD &/or officer(s) attending.

Adjournment was at 2:30 pm






